PETITION FOR APPOINTMENT OF PROBATE CONSERVATOR OF THE PERSON AND ESTATE

TENTATIVE RULING: The matter is CONTINUED to July 25, 2019, 8:30 a.m. in Dept. A, in order for Petitioners to address the following issues in the filings. The Petition asserts a bond is to be fixed but fails to state an amount. Based on section 3, subsection (e) of the Petition, the Court calculates the proper amount for the bond as \$465,506.80. The proposed order on file would fix the bond at \$336,708. Sections 3, 4 subsections (b) and (c), and 9 subsection (d) of the Petition are incomplete. No attachments to the Petition are included, as required based on the orders requested. The Capacity Declaration (GC-335) on file is inconsistent with the powers and determinations sought through the Petition. The Petition is not one for appointment of a Successor Conservator, however, section 1, subd. (g) of the Petition prays the successor conservator be granted powers. The Petition is silent as to whether proposed Conservatee is receiving or entitled to receive benefits from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. The Confidential Conservator Screening Form for proposed conservator Betsinda Biederman is incomplete in that items 15 and 20 are blank. Section 8 of the Proposed Orders is inconsistent with the Court Investigator's Report. Sections 9 and 28 of the Proposed Orders would grant powers not requested by the Petition. There are no proposed letters on file.
