TENTATIVE RULING: The motion is GRANTED. Through her opposition (titled “Response”) Defendant submits evidence that she responded to interrogatories and requests for production of documents. The present motion, however, seeks an order regarding requests for admissions. Plaintiff submits evidence that Defendant failed to timely respond to the subject requests and therefore all objections to the requests for admissions are deemed waived. (Code Civ. Proc., § 2033.280, subd. (a).) Unless Defendant has served, before the hearing on the motion, a proposed response to the requests for admission, that is in substantial compliance with Code of Civil Procedure section 2033.220, the truth of the matters specified in Plaintiff’s request for admissions are deemed admitted by Defendant. (*Id.*, § 2033.280, subd. (b).)
